Modern-day slavery, or human trafficking, is the exploitation of human beings through force, fraud or coercion for the purposes of commercial sex or forced labor. It is a problem affecting 50 million people globally. Currently, the second largest criminal activity in the world, trafficking garners \$236 billion annually for the perpetrators off the labor of their victims.

The International Supply Chain Protection Organization supports the efforts of TAT (Truckers Against Trafficking) as they work across multiple sectors of the supply chain to build a mobile army activated to assist law enforcement on roadways and in communities. Through its mission to educate, equip, empower and mobilize key industries and agencies to combat human trafficking, and its creation of free industry-specific training, TAT is turning passive bystanders into active disruptors by teaching the signs of human trafficking and how to make a simple phone call to report suspicious activity.
